

## Procedure for entry into the Sixth Form in September 2019

### Introduction

Entry into the Sixth Form is by examination, interview and report, and we accept approximately 50 applicants each year. Applicants are normally under 17 years of age on 1st September 2019.

An essential part of the process is to visit the School. This can be done as a private visit or as part of an Open Morning. On either occasion it will be possible to have a tour of the School and to meet with senior staff. ### Step 1: Registration

The first step in the admissions process is to register via the WISEPAY link on the main Admissions page and submit the Registration form and non-refundable £200 registration fee. Sixth Form entry registration is kept confidential until such a time as a reference is required. Candidates must register before being sent the link to the online application form.

All candidates are expected to submit their most recent set of school reports when they register.

**Deadline for REGISTRATION Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018.** No registrations will be considered after this date.

### Step 2: On-line Examination Application Form

Following Registration and towards the end of August, the link to the on-line examination application form will be sent to you. A personal statement and a recent photograph are required as part of the on-line application.

Candidates are asked to inform their current Head Teachers of their application.

We will ask for a Confidential Report from their school and this will form part of the assessment procedure.

**Deadline for APPLICATION FORMS: Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2018.**

### Examination Date: Friday 9 or Saturday 10 November 2018

When completing the online application form, candidates should express a preference for one of the above dates for the examination. The majority of candidates will sit the examinations at The King's School, but in exceptional circumstances overseas candidates may take them in British Council offices or other agreed venues. **All candidates will be interviewed and all should have visited the School.** The examination will consist of three papers: a General Paper and two subjects of the candidate's choosing.

Academic Scholarships may be awarded on the basis of performance in the entrance examinations. Music, Art and Sports Scholarships are also available. All Scholarships are capped at 10% of fees but means-tested Bursaries are also available. For details please contact the Admissions Office:
