Note

As in national results tables, the newer grades 9 and 8 are taken to be equivalent to the old A*, and grade 7 is equivalent to an A, grade 6 to a B and grades 5 and 4 to a C grade.

The majority of grades awarded in 2018 were letter grades (A*-E); the majority in 2019 were number grades; all grades awarded in 2022, for the first time, were number grades (9-1).
